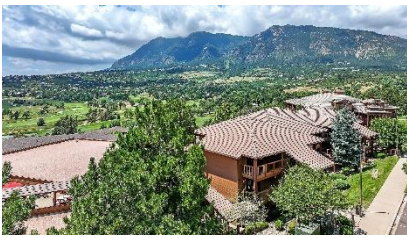
Please book your room for dates pre and/or post retreat as soon as possible after you have registered.

It is the responsibility of all participants to book their own transport to and from Cheyenne Mountain Resort. The resort is a quick and easy 15-minute drive from Colorado Springs airport, perfect for taxi or Uber.

Preparation

Spending time in the presence of Louix will bring immense infusions of Light into your body. To prepare yourself, and to ensure you receive the highest amount possible, it is highly recommended that, for at least 3 days prior to the retreat, you consume foods and liquids that cleanse and purify your body. Increase your intake of pure water, raw fruits and vegetables, and green superfoods (such as spirulina, wheat grass, etc., if they are already in your diet). Cut back on refined sugar, caffeine, nicotine, alcohol, processed foods, meat, and dairy.

Telephone

Phone calls made from within your room will be billed directly to you at the end of the retreat. Please check the rates before using the phones in the hotel, as there may be extra charges for phone usage, and calls can be quite expensive.

Please do not take cell phones into the main meeting hall or dining area to receive or take calls. If required, you may make calls during breaks or from your room. It is recommended that you keep your contact with the outside world to a minimum and immerse yourself in the retreat and the vortex being created.

WiFi

Complimentary WiFi is provided for each guest for use around the venue. A password will be given upon check-in. As with phone calls, it is recommended for the duration of the retreat that you refrain from using the Internet, unless absolutely necessary.

Pools and Spa



Cheyenne Mountain Resort offers guests a variety of pool options, including two outdoor pools and an indoor pool. There's also a kiddie pool and a splash pad for younger guests. The indoor pool features lap lanes and a slide. Guests can also enjoy a heated outdoor hot tub.

Retreat Specifics:

Food & Meals



Vegan meals and beverages (including purified drinking water) will be provided during the retreat. Your first meal will be dinner served on Monday, 29 December 2025 at 6:30 p.m. The final meal will be lunch served on Saturday, 3 January 2026.

No alcohol or caffeinated products will be served or made available during the retreat (with the exception of green tea and yerba mate tea).

- Smoking is NOT allowed in or around all guest rooms, around the swimming pool, dining room, and all public areas.

Dress

- Please dress respectfully during the retreat. While casual clothing is allowed, it is recommended that you bring at least one dressy outfit (for our New Year's Eve celebration). In addition, while many people do choose to wear white or some form of sacred clothing during Darshan and/or other ceremonies (a tradition around spiritual Masters), this is not a requirement; you may wear what you feel is appropriate for you. If you are unsure, or have further questions, please call.
- It is also a good idea to bring a wrap or blanket to have with you during the retreat, as it is quite common for people to go through energy shifts and temperature changes when healings take place. There may also be some outdoor activities as part of the program.
- Please do not wear shoes in the meeting room. There will be a designated area provided outside the room to store them. If your feet tend to get cold, please bring socks.
- Wearing perfume, cologne, or fragrant oils of any kind (except 100% pure essential oils) is prohibited for the duration of this retreat—in or outside of our group sessions/gatherings.
- Please bring something for lying on the ground *outside* as well, as Louix often teaches and leads spiritual techniques, exercises, and/or ceremonies which require sitting or lying on the ground.

Health

If you have any specific health or medical needs, please let us know when you fill out the Medical Information Form that is included in the Welcome Packet.

Recording & Photography

- Attendees are welcome to take photos during the retreat. However, please use discretion when taking pictures and be sensitive to the physical and emotional needs of others, especially when using a flash. If you have a digital camera, please turn off all sounds.
- Cheyenne Mountain Resort is first and foremost a vacation spot for all its guests. Resort management asks that guests' privacy be respected at all times. Therefore, taking photographs of or filming other hotel guests (not with our group) is not allowed under any circumstance.
- Please do not bring any type of audio/video recording equipment to the retreat, other than cameras.

Caring for Your Children

Children of all ages (infants included) are welcome at the retreat. Their love and joy is a blessing to all of us. During the retreat, a roster of staff members will be assigned to oversee the needs of the children throughout the day. There will be activities that are stimulating and fun, including the swimming pool, for them to enjoy. Children are always welcome to participate in any aspect of the retreat. If your child has any special needs, please let us know.

Tips & Gratuities

As indicated on your registration form, all taxes and gratuities are included in the cost during retreat dates only. Therefore, there are no additional charges or gratuities required for porters, housekeeping, or for any food or meals that are included as part of the retreat package.

How to Get There

The closest airport to Cheyenne Mountain Resort is Colorado Springs Airport (COS) which is 9.8 miles from the hotel.

PLEASE NOTE: It is the responsibility of each participant to book their own transport to and from Cheyenne Mountain Resort.
Taxis and Ubers are easy and readily available.

Passports & Visa

To enter the United States, most foreign citizens need a valid passport and may also need a visa or ESTA (Electronic System for Travel Authorization). Passport validity requirements may vary, but generally, it should be valid for at least six months beyond your intended stay. If eligible, you can enter under the Visa Waiver Program (VWP) using an approved ESTA. If not eligible for the VWP, you will need a visa.

Travel Insurance

Travel insurance is your responsibility, and it is highly recommended to cover any losses from trip cancellations, natural disasters, unexpected illness, loss of luggage, etc. Please contact your local travel agent to obtain insurance information.

Climate

The weather in Colorado Springs from December to January has an average daily high temperature of around 50F (5°C), and an average low of 16F (-8°C).

Layers are recommended for maximum comfort. The low humidity keeps out the deep cold found in other destinations, and snow may be forecast but it melts and evaporates quickly. It is recommended that you bring a warm jacket and any other items of clothing you may feel necessary to manage the cold weather, as well as a good pair of walking shoes for outdoor gatherings or activities. Administration

All attendees **must** sign and return a **Recording Release, Liability Waiver, and Medical Information, and Additional Information** form as a condition of attendance at this event. If you do not complete all of these forms in DocuSign, you will not be permitted to participate in the retreat.
